

As part of Transport Scotland's strategic trunk road management programme, Scotland TranServ is proposing to resurface **1.2km** of the A737 between Roadhead Roundabout and Clerksbridge Toll Roundabout, north of Beith.

The scheme has been rescheduled from an earlier programme, where Scotland TranServ identified a number of similar projects in the area following consultation with local authorities and key stakeholders. The decision was taken to reduce the impact on the traveling public.

We are now proposing to carry out the works **under a full weekend closure** of the carriageway between -

8pm on Friday the 13th until 6am on Monday the 16th of September.

This is necessary in order that we can complete this project as quickly and safely as possible.

Additional clearing works are also required prior to the start of resurfacing. In order to complete the necessary removal of this vegetation we require **two overnight closures** of the carriageway:

8pm on Wednesday 11th to 6am on Thursday 12th of September

and

8pm on Thursday 12th to 6am on Friday 13th of September.

Local diversions will be in place throughout this short programme of works. Drivers will be advised to allow plenty of extra time for their journeys.
